## **Be a GOOD Witness**

#### When calling 911 or the Non-Emergency line... Remain calm and answer these basic questions:

- □ **WHAT** happened?
- □ WHERE did it happen?
- □ WHEN did it happen?
- □ WHO was involved?
- □ **HOW** it happened?

#### Be able to provide detailed description(s):

#### Persons:

- □ Male/Female
- □ Race/Ethnicity
- □ Height/Weight
- □ Approximate age
- □ Hair color/Facial hair
- □ Clothing/Hat
- □ Scars, marks, tattoos, language/speech or traits

#### Vehicles/Objects:

- □ Type (sedan/pickup, etc.)
- □ Color(s)
- □ Make/Model/Year
- □ License/Serial Number
- □ Features/Markings
- □ Direction of travel
- You're NOT required to provide your name and number to the calltaker, but it is helpful to conduct a complete investigation.
- You may request to NOT be contacted by the investigating officer, but an interview is helpful to conduct a complete investigation.
